

Allen Township Trustees

June 2, 2015

The Allen Township Trustees met in regular session at 7:00 p.m. in the Allen Township Center with all members present. The minutes of May 5, 2015 were read and approved as read.

The Fiscal Officer presented a list of warrants and electronic payments totaling \$20,921.56. Flanagan moved to pay these bills. The motion was seconded by Huffman. Roll call - all yes.

Fire chief Hickman presented a quote to purchase 20 pagers for the ATVFD from Radio Hospital in the amount of \$10,267.40. Flanagan moved to accept the quote and purchase 20 new pagers. The motion was seconded by Huffman. Roll call - all yes.

Huffman advised that he attended a solid waste meeting a couple of weeks ago. Much of the discussions revolved around updating the recycling facilities at Litter Landing.

Flanagan moved that Allen Township go forward with Keith Brenneman establishing a web-site for Allen Township at a cost of \$150 to create the site and \$25 per month thereafter to maintain the site. Huffman seconded the motion. Roll call - all yes.

There was a short discussion concerning the effects of the Affordable Care Act (ACA) on the reimbursement of health insurance to the elected officials of Allen Township. Basically, the ACA has made the reimbursement of health insurance by townships unlawful with significant fines if they persist in do so beyond 6/30/15. Per correspondence from the Auditor of State's Office on 3/26/15, the Ohio Attorney General's office was requested several months ago for an opinion and his guidance as to these issues and the vast impact it has on townships across the state. However, at this point in time there has been no new information on the subject. Flanagan moved that healthcare reimbursements to the Trustees and the Fiscal Officer be suspended effective 7/1/2015. Stacy seconded the motion. Roll call - all yes.

The next regular meeting will be July 7, 2015 at 7:00 p.m.
