

Allen Township Trustees

April 3, 2012

The Allen Township Trustees met in regular session at 7:00 p.m. in the Allen Township Center with all members present. The minutes of March 6, 2012 were read and approved as read.

The Fiscal Officer presented a list of bills (warrants 4201 - 4228) totaling \$45,818.34. Flanagan moved to pay these bills. The motion was seconded by Stacy. Roll call - all yes.

Tony Humphrey presented the monthly road inspections. The documented observations were reviewed with action plans being developed where appropriate and noted on the inspection forms.

Schimmoller advised the annual notice of liquor permit renewals has been received if the Trustees would like to object to any of the liquor permits that exist in Allen Township now is the time to do it. After a brief discussion no action was taken.

A response from Miller Construction dated March 5, 2012 regarding the damage to TR-142 last summer was received. Basically they are not willing to assume any responsibility for the damage to TR-142 in the area where they were entering and exiting the road. Flanagan spoke with Josh Clay yesterday and challenged some of the comments in the letter. Josh will speak with the owners and get back to Kevin.

Thomas Welch from OTARMA was in attendance to review the township's insurance policy renewal for 2012. Flanagan moved to increase the cemetery coverage from \$5,000 to \$20,000. Huffman seconded the motion. Roll call - all yes.

Huffman presented a quote from Findlay Implement to trade-in the township's 2010 JD Z920A cemetery mower for a 2012 JD A920A Commercial ZTrak 60" 7-Iron PRO cemetery mower at a net cost of \$2,150. Stacy moved that the quote be accepted. Flanagan seconded the motion. Roll call - all yes.

Hickman advised that four firemen have completed their EMT training and that fire hydrant flushing will begin soon.

The next regular meeting will be May 1, 2012 at 7:00 p.m.
