

## Allen Township Trustees

**May 1, 2012**

The Allen Township Trustees met in regular session at 7:00 p.m. in the Allen Township Center with all members in attendance.

The minutes of April 3, 2012 were read and approved as read.

The Fiscal Officer presented a list of warrants (4229 - 4260) totaling \$21,659.08 for outstanding bills. Stacy moved to pay these bills with Flanagan seconding. Roll call - all yes.

Tony Humphrey presented the monthly road inspections. The documented observations were reviewed with action plans being developed where appropriate and noted on the inspection forms.

Flanagan reported that he spoke with Josh from Miller Construction and the owners are still unwilling to pay for any damages to TR-142 from last summer. Flanagan will be contacting Cindy Land with the prosecutor's office to discuss the issue further.

Kandy Smith was in attendance to get an update on the outlet replacement on TR-108. The Trustees advised her that they are considering hiring another contractor to complete the job started by Randy Boes. Huffman advised that he has a bid from Rick Hoenbrink for \$7,170 plus \$690 for grading and seeding to complete the project. Stacy moved to accept the bid from Hoenbrink. Flanagan seconded the motion. Roll call – all yes.

Hickman advised that 4 fireman have completed EMT Training.

Huffman advised that Wolford Landscaping was unable to produce a pesticide license to perform spraying at the cemetery. Flanagan moved that the cemetery spraying contract with Wolford Landscaping be revoked. Stacy seconded the motion. Roll call – all yes.

Flanagan presented a bid to do road striping for \$2,100 from Oglesby Construction. Stacy moved to accept the bid with Flanagan seconding the motion. Roll call – all yes.
