

Allen Township Trustees

June 5, 2012

The Allen Township Trustees met in regular session at 7:00 p.m. in the Allen Township Center with all members present. The minutes of May 1, 2012 were read and approved as read.

The Fiscal Officer presented a list of bills (warrants 4261 - 4287) totaling \$17,484.49. Flanagan moved to pay these bills. The motion was seconded by Stacy. Roll call - all yes.

Tony Humphrey presented the monthly road inspections. The documented observations were reviewed with action plans being developed where appropriate and noted on the inspection forms.

Flanagan reported that he spoke with Cindy Land from the prosecutor's office regarding the Miller Construction issue regarding the damage to TR-142 last summer. Cindy advised that it would be extremely difficult to take legal action on this issue. After a brief discussion the Trustees decided to drop the issue.

Hickman advised that Gibson began work on the Fire Station this week to repair the wall that was damaged by a storm last year. He also reported that the flushing of fire hydrants is nearly complete.

The Fiscal Officer presented the Abstract of Driver Records to the Trustees for all Township personnel who may be in a position to drive Allen Township vehicles. After a brief review of the driving records by the Trustees no action was taken.

There was nothing new to report on the outlet replacement project on TR-108. Neither Boes nor Hoenbrink have been out to complete the project yet.

Stacy presented a \$3,000 estimate from Boes Brothers for mowing brush and digging trees off the bank and dipping the ditch in the field North of the Township Center. Flanagan moved to accept the estimate with Stacy seconding the motion. Roll call - all yes.

Huffman reported that he met with representatives from the State of Ohio regarding the installation of a drainage outlet starting at TR-216 and going South through the State Park. The State has proposed to provide the equipment and labor if Allen Township and the affected residents will provide the materials. Stacy will contact Nick Moser and the other affected residents to discuss the proposal.

The next regular meeting will be July 3, 2012 at 7:00 p.m.
