

Allen Township Trustees

June 7, 2016

The Allen Township Trustees met in regular session at 7:00 p.m. in the Allen Township Center with all members present.

The minutes of May 3, 2016 were read and approved as read.

The Fiscal Officer presented a list of warrants and electronic payments totaling \$19,595.07. Flanagan moved to pay these bills. The motion was seconded by Huffman. Roll call - all yes.

John Rettig from the ATFD was in attendance to represent Chief Hickman who is on vacation. John presented the Trustees with an idea of purchasing a used 1988 fire truck with a 55' ladder that is for sale. The asking price is a minimum \$9,500. The frame is in need of approximately \$6,000 - \$8,000 worth of repairs. Huffman moved that the ATVFD make an offer of \$9,500 for the truck as it sits. Flanagan seconded the motion. Roll call – all yes. John also advised that in attempting to get bids on a potential new fire station, it appears that an architect will be needed before any quotes can be acquired. The Trustees will look into locating an architect for the project.

Huffman advised that he met with assistant Hancock County Engineer Doug Cade regarding turning the intersections of TR142 - TR109 and TR218 – TR232 into 4-way stops. Doug advised that both of these intersections do not meet the county criteria for establishing a 4-way stop. The Trustees will look into trimming trees at both of these intersections to improve visibility.

Flanagan advised that he received an e-mail from Scott Sharpe ODNR regarding the outlet tile project on TR218. The ODNR has verbally agreed to honor the original agreement of the Township providing the tile and ODNR providing the installation. ODNR will provide a formal agreement stating the same in the very near future.

The next regular meeting will be July 5, 2016 at 7:00 p.m.
