

Allen Township Trustees

August 1, 2017

The Allen Township Trustees met in regular session at 7:00 p.m. in the Allen Township Center with Huffman and Stacy present.

The minutes of July 4, 2017 were read and approved as read.

The Fiscal Officer presented a list of warrants and electronic payments totaling \$190,490.01. Stacy moved to pay these bills. The motion was seconded by Huffman. Roll call - all yes.

Schimmoeller reported that everything required for the \$27k reimbursement from the state has been sent in on the NatureWorks Grant project at the Sportsplex.

Karim Baroudi Hancock Public Health Commissioner was in attendance to give a brief report on the merger of the two health departments. Ashley gave a brief report on the mosquito monitoring activities in Hancock County.

Rex Rinker and Jacob Deiter (Boy Scout Troup 313) were in attendance to discuss any potential Eagle projects that may be available in the township.

Jeana Campbell (TR216) was in attendance to discuss placing lights on the High School soccer field in Van Buren. She is pursuing ways to finance the \$200k project and was exploring ways in which possibly the township could assist. Short discussion ensued regarding financing projects of this nature. No action was taken.

Fire Chief Hickman provided an update on the idea of installing Opticom equipment on three of the fire trucks at a cost of \$995 each. It is unclear at this time if there would be any added installation or maintenance costs on this equipment. Opticom controls the traffic lights in an emergency situation. He also advised that the firemen are still flushing hydrants.

Tony Humphrey provided an update on the road maintenance and the cemetery. An estimate from Millstream Fence & Home Improvement was presented on replacing a portion of the cemetery fence. A couple of additional estimates are pending.

The next regular meeting will be September 5, 2017 at 7:00 p.m.
