

Allen Township Trustees

February 6, 2018

The Allen Township Trustees met in regular session at 7:00 p.m. in the Allen Township Center with Huffman and Stacy present. The minutes of January 2, 2018 were read and approved as read.

Schimmoeller provided the Trustees with the yearend 2017 financial reports and reviewed the highlights with them.

The Fiscal Officer presented a Resolution to permanently appropriate the \$3,256,163.34 amount certified by the Hancock County Budget Commission for 2018. Stacy moved to adopt the resolution and Huffman seconded the motion. Roll call - all yes

The Fiscal Officer presented a list of bills totaling \$29,841.54. Huffman moved to pay these bills. The motion was seconded by Stacy. Roll call - all yes.

Hickman advised that the Workmans Comp Environmental Grant has been received and the equipment has been ordered.

Tony Humphrey provided an update on the road maintenance and the cemetery.

Stacy gave an update on the TR-218 drainage project. A letter dated January 19, 2018 was received from the Hancock County Health Department. The five household sewage systems along TR 218 have been assessed and deemed to be working properly. Stacy has advised ODNR of the Health Department's findings. Estimates to make the connection of the road tile, that includes these households, to the new outlet that runs south through the Van Buren State Park to the Rocky Ford will be sought.

Huffman advised that Joe Bayliff is still finalizing the plans for the new fire station.
