The Allen Township Trustees met in regular session at 7:00 p.m. in the Allen Township Center with all members present.

The minutes of February 6, 2018 were read and approved as read.

The Fiscal Officer presented a list of warrants and electronic payments totaling \$75,001.19 for outstanding bills. Flanagan moved to pay these bills with Stacy seconding. Roll call - all yes.

Paul Craun was in attendance to discuss his interest in running for Hancock County Commissioner.

Fire Chief Hickman discussed details of a Cost Recovery Program for the township. He shared some of the other township's billing structures.

Tony Humphrey provided an update on the road maintenance and the cemetery.

Flanagan initiated a conversation regarding last Friday's road survey by the Trustees. He presented some notes from the survey with a list of items to be addressed.

Flanagan advised that he attended the DAC meeting which was held last night.

Flanagan moved that Allen Township pay the Hancock County Engineer's office to inspect all of the road signs once per year. Stacy seconded the motion. Roll call - all yes.

Stacy moved that Allen Township pay the Hancock County Engineer's office to handle emergency sign replacements for the township. Flanagan seconded the motion. Roll call - all yes.

Huffman gave an update on the new fire station project.
