June 5, 2018

The Allen Township Trustees met in regular session at 7:00 p.m. in the Allen Township Center with all members present.

The minutes of May 1, 2018 were read and approved as read.

The Fiscal Officer presented a list of warrants and electronic payments totaling \$19,705.32. Stacy moved to pay these bills. The motion was seconded by Flanagan. Roll call - all yes.

Tom Whitta (Whitta Construction) was in attendance to present a couple of estimates for road repairs. He recommends crack filling on TR215 for \$8,000 and chip-sealing TR109 (CR220 – TR140) for \$48,110. Stacy moved to accept the estimates with Flanagan seconded the motion. Roll call - all yes.

Hickman advised that the hydrant flushing is under way and five new pagers were purchased to replace several older ones.

Fire Chief Hickman reported on the past month's activities with the fire department.

Tony Humphrey provided an update on road maintenance activities for the past month.

Flanagan advised that he attended the last Regional Planning Meeting and reported on the topics.

Huffman reported on the status of the new fire station after his conversation with Joe Baliff. After much discussion, the new fire station project has been put on hold.
