

Allen Township Trustees

June 4, 2019

The Allen Township Trustees met in regular session at 7:00 p.m. in the Allen Township Center with all members present.

The minutes of May 7, 2019 were read and approved as read.

The Fiscal Officer presented a list of warrants and electronic payments totaling \$26,326.58. Huffman moved to pay these bills. The motion was seconded by Stacy. Roll call - all yes.

Fire Chief Hickman reported on the past month's activities with the fire department.

Tony Humphrey provided an update on road maintenance activities for the past month.

Stacy had nothing new to report from Cindy Land on the new fire station bid package. A discussion regarding the new fire station ensued and the trials and tribulations of the project. Possible next steps were discussed with no action being taken on the matter.

Huffman reported that he was unable to attend the latest solid waste meeting.

Flanagan advised that the cemetery fence at SR613 & TR232 was damaged again. This time by a semi looking for Home Depot that did not take the corner wide enough. An accident report from the State Highway Patrol is pending.

Flanagan reported on his attendance at the latest Regional Planning meeting.

Resident Cindy Brian was in attendance to thank the Trustees for jetting the tile on the south side of TR 114 along her property. It has improved the drainage on her property significantly. She requested that the Trustees put a cross-over pipe from the south side to the north side of TR114 to help drain the front of her property. The Trustees informed Cindy that the tile on the south side of the road is 12" lower than the tile on the north side. Therefore, the addition of a cross-over pipe is not feasible. Tony Humphrey suggested that a French drain in Cindy's front yard may help the pooling water go down faster. The Trustees agreed and explained to Cindy how a French drain works and that it would be at her expense.

The next regular meeting will be July 2, 2019 at 7:00 p.m.
