

Allen Township Trustees

June 2, 2020

The Allen Township Trustees met in regular session at 7:00 p.m. in the Allen Township Center with all members present.

The minutes of May 5, 2020 were read and approved.

Several Sportsplex (baseball/softball) representatives were in attendance to discuss the reopening of the Sportsplex since being closed for the COVID-19 pandemic. Brooks Lance baseball coach at VB spoke about many other baseball facilities (excluding VBHS) that have recently reopened. Jeff Ramp spoke on behalf of the VBCSA. Stacy Sharp VB girls softball coach also spoke. The group requested the Trustees to allow the Sportsplex baseball fields to be reopened as soon as possible in an effort to salvage a portion of the traveling baseball season for VB youth. They would be willing to follow any guidelines that would be required. Brooks presented a release of liability form that he has seen others using. The Trustees advised that they would not be comfortable reopening the Sportsplex without speaking with the Hancock County Prosecutor's office first. Cindy Land will be contacted tomorrow for advise on this issue.

Township resident Deb Oberle was in attendance to discuss a drainage issue at her property on Chagrin Falls. The Trustees will contact Boes Brothers to meet at the location to assess the situation.

The Fiscal Officer presented a list of warrants and electronic payments totaling \$19,381.92. Flanagan moved to pay these bills. The motion was seconded by Huffman. Roll call - all yes.

Fire Chief Hickman reported on the past month's activities with the fire department.

Tony Humphrey provided an update on road maintenance activities for the past month.

Stacy reported on the Fire Equipment Building. Helms Construction has yet to provide a building schedule.

The next regular meeting will be July 7, 2020 at 7:00 p.m.
